I/We, _____ agree to act as a foster home for the Winona Area Humane Society (WAHS). I/We agree to the following:

1. The animal(s) are and remain the property of WAHS.
2. The animal(s) will be kept inside the home.
3. Dogs may not be tied out without direct supervision except for short periods.

4. All veterinary care must be **pre-approved by WAHS**.
5. If requested and available, food will be provided to the foster while they are caring for the foster animal(s) as long as WAHS is informed at least five days before a foster is running low on food. The foster will pick food up at a designated drop site.
6. If any questions or problems arise, the foster should immediately contact WAHS.
7. The foster home accepts all responsibility for any events that may occur as a result of fostering the animal(s). WAHS is not liable for any injuries to people, pets or for any loss or damage to property. Consult your homeowner's policy to be sure that you are covered for injuries to people or animals outside your home.
8. Foster homes have the right of first refusal should they become attached to an animal in their care, unless a verbal agreement has already been reached with a potential adoptive family. If a foster is interested in adopting an animal(s), they should notify the WAHS as soon as possible so that the animal(s) may be listed as "on hold" status. The foster home has no more than fourteen (14) days to complete the adoption.

If the adoption is not completed within that time, the foster animal(s) become available to the general public for adoption and the right of first refusal is expired.

9. Providing foster care is an earnest and important commitment. **Foster homes must commit to the care of the animal until it is no longer in foster**, unless there are extreme and serious circumstances that prevent the foster from being able to adequately care for the dog or cat.
